BRODISE is an EU- funded project supported by Horizon 2020 Framework Program. Its focus relies on the search of innovative technological solutions addressing the challenges triggered by soil contamination of former industrial areas. In this context, one of the objectives of the project is to raise awareness of knowledge-based organisations and of the market (namely innovation-driven companies) about a new paradigm in terms of public procurement. The later is boosted by innovation and cooperative activities, leading to the development of efficient decontamination solutions which are more viable economically.

The Technical Dialogue targets potential solution providers for brownfields. Such instrument is the appointed mechanism for informing the market about the characteristics of the three industrial areas studied previously on the behalf of BRODISE project (Seixal, Bilbao and Trieste), namely: 1) current levels of contamination; 2) characterisation of contamination sources (identification and concentration of contaminants, etc.) and 3) future land-use (medium and long term). Likewise, there was also a survey which has retrieved technical information about existing technologies (and/or in development) for fulfilling the needs expressed above.

This public event is a privileged source of information aiming at to stimulate the market to encourage the development of innovative solutions for soil decontamination, bearing in mind the preliminary work carried out under the framework of BRODISE project and also previous experiences of the market whenever approaching similar problems.
